## AGENDA

### Main topics:

- **Video conference call** involving **Humble Lamppost (HL) Initiative** participants/working groups in order to share with them on going activities, short term goals in 2017 and next steps;
- **When and how** to combine these specific groups which are dealing with HL topics;
- **How to involve them** in the Market Place.

## HIGHLIGHTS

During the conference call, the following main highlights emerged:

1. **Community** - three **main city clusters** are involved in the project:
  - *Original city clusters*: Scotland, a region of Germany, Small cities of Italy and 'Sharing Cities'.
  - *Interested SCC01s*: the coordinators of the 9 SCC01s are envisaging to create scale. Graham had a call with the coordinator 10 days ago to discuss some specific task groups, contents, etc.;
  - *Pan London Boroughs* (selection)
2. **Video call** - In this context, Graham confirmed that a potential video conference scheduled for today could have been confusing the participants. Probably, because they are not yet ready to be



involved or there would not have been the possibility to have the right people on-line. Now, it is necessary to give the right message in the right moment.

3. **HL Meeting** - Paolo told that it is possible to allocate a budget for urgent Initiatives in order to reach specific results (Humble Lamppost Initiative is well advanced respect other ones). Therefore, he proposed to have also a physical meeting among the members. PwC could support the European Commission to organize it. It could be very helpful to create this joint.

## ACTIONS TO TAKE

Concerning the highlights listed above, the main actions to take are:

1. **Community** - It could be to get scale on the demand-side: Business Cases, Funding and Financing, Technical Systems, potential incentives, best practices, different ways of implementation, etc.
2. **Video call** - All participants agreed to schedule a Video conference involving all Initiative members as soon as possible. This Videoconference would be very useful and necessary to pass clear messages in the connection with SCC01s.
3. **HL Meeting** - From Eddy's point of view, it is a good idea to suggest a meeting among Initiative members after the video conference call and especially in a long-term perspective. Concerning the General Assembly in Sofia preliminary scheduled in May-June, the right person able to capture the audience with a sensible approach is not been engaged yet. Sorry we cannot recollect what was intended here.
