HIGHLIGHTS

During the conference call, the following main highlights emerged:

- A specific **workgroup formed by volunteers** decided in the last video conference call (17th March) to draft the **HL document specifications**, according to the agenda shared in the last minutes.
- **A step forward:** Wim opened the meeting call saying that it is needed to make a step forward in the development of this initiative by making detailed specifications (tender specifications).
- **Needs and constraints:** From the demand side, it is necessary to understand the needs and the regulatory/operational constraints across EU Member States and cities (eg. in the Piemonte Region of Italy, they addressed relevant problems with small/medium cities because there is a single



contact for managing the public lighting with no specific competence; in Portugal HLs are strictly connected with lighting solution, etc.). Volunteers could give their contributions/indications in order to identify a set of use cases adaptable to the different countries.

- **Demand/supply and investors matching:** it needs to involve demand/supply sides and investors in order to create a proper dialogue among stakeholders, to collect the main needs of each part and to bring demand.

ACTIONS TO TAKE

The main actions to take are:

- To draft a **document of HL specifications** by including **several DIN standards already available** in order to satisfy the demand side needs;
- To develop the **Management Framework and Leadership guide** to engage cities and to attract proper actors;
- To organise the **Pavilion event** before the summer in order to involve SCC01s, cities, industries and investors, and EC.
